This past February, during Black History Month, we focused on notable African American figures who recently passed and left behind a beautiful legacy. Cooper and Caeson Barnes did a wonderful monologue about Henry Louis Aaron, also known as Hank Aaron (nicknamed Hammer), in which, big brother, Cooper lovingly schooled little brother, Caeson on Mr. Aaron's amazing baseball career. Mr. Aaron battled racism throughout his career and was inducted to the Baseball Hall of Fame. Amaya Wilkerson wrote and presented on model turned actress, Cicely Tyson. Ms. Tyson made the decision to use her career as a platform to uplift black people and never play the stereotypical roles Hollywood wrote for black actresses. She stuck to her decision until her death. Amaya also spoke about the first historically black college and university, Lincoln University located in Pennsylvania, which still exists today. McKena Allen researched and spoke about civil rights icon, John Lewis. He famously led hundreds of marchers from Selma to Montgomery, AL on March 7, 1965, now known as Bloody Sunday. Lastly, McKena taught us about a slave named Onesimus, who introduced the African practice of what is now known as vaccination to the Massachusetts colony during the smallpox outbreak in 1721.
